Who can participate?

Eligible students entering 9th through 12th grade will be able to enroll in VDLIA. Students entering 7th or 8th grade can prepare to enter VDLIA by taking Vietnamese 1P and 2P at Dale Junior High School. Vietnamese 1P and 2P are also offered at Magnolia High School. Native Vietnamese speakers are not required to take Vietnamese 1P and 2P but an entrance exam is required. Students need to possess the fundamentals of communication skills in Vietnamese to be able to participate in VDLIA.

Do You Live Outside of the Anaheim Union High School District Area?

♦ Dale Junior High School and Magnolia High School will accept all students from all districts in the Southern California regardless of your address. Parents will need to request an **Interdistrict Transfer** form from the district of residence. After it is approved, bring it to the AUHSD Office and fill out the registration application to attend Dale Junior High School or Magnolia High School.

Do You Live inside of the AUHSD Attendance Area?

♦ Students who reside within the district boundaries may apply for enrollment in Dale Junior High School or Magnolia High School by School of Choice. School of Choice applications are being accepted by AUHSD.
